The juror of selection and awards is **Gretchen G. Keyworth**, Director and Chief Curator of the Fuller Craft Museum, Brockton, MA since 2004.

Keyworth served as a consultant for Fine Furnishings-Providence, The Society of Arts and Crafts, Boston, MA; Martha's Vineyard Glassworks, and as a curator for the Hawaii Craftsmen Association. She has curated and organized numerous exhibitions including: *Glassforms*; *Charles Kaziun, Early Works and Traditional Paperweights*; *The Domestic Object*, a juried traveling exhibition for the Year of the Craft; *Garden Treasures II* and *Garden Treasures III*.

Ten \$200 awards will be awarded at the juror's discretion.

CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY

Crafts National is open to all artists who design and produce their own work. Eligible media includes ceramics, fiber, glass, wood, paper, mixed media and other.

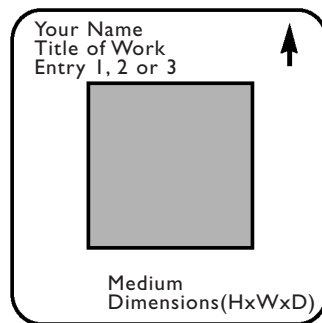
ENTRY FEE

Each application must be accompanied by a \$25 non-refundable entry fee. Make checks payable to **Lancaster Museum of Art**.

SLIDES

Artists may enter up to three works. Submit one slide per work. Work designed as a set will constitute one entry.

Work will be judged on the basis of 2"x 2" 35mm slides. Glass or metal mounted slides will not be considered. Each slide must be clearly marked with the following information: Name, Title, Medium, Size (height x width x depth), Top (marked with an arrow) and Entry Number (to correspond with your entry form). **Your application must be accompanied by a self-addressed stamped envelope for return of slides and jury decision notice.**



Mark slide 1, 2 or 3.
Put arrow in top right
to indicate top of slide.

DELIVERY & RETURN OF WORK

Upon notification of acceptance, works must be shipped or mailed, prepaid, in sturdy, reusable packaging to arrive on or before March 17, 2006. **Artists are responsible for return shipping costs.** The Lancaster Museum of Art will not be responsible for any damage incurred in transit.

The Lancaster Museum of Art reserves the right to exclude any work when the work differs from the slide entry.

Entries must remain on display through the close of the exhibition.

CATALOG

The Lancaster Museum of Art will publish a catalog containing a list of the participating artists, images of the prize winners and statement by the juror. The catalog will be available to visitors during the exhibition and be nationally distributed to museums, galleries and curators.

INSURANCE

The Lancaster Museum of Art will provide Fine Arts Insurance for the exhibition on site. Consent to reproduce for publicity, catalog or educational purposes is assumed, unless specifically reserved in writing. Submission of entry constitutes agreement to all conditions in the prospectus.

SALES

The Lancaster Museum of Art charges a 30% commission fee on all sales. Please include commission in sales price listed. Works not for sale **must** list an insurance value.
